



Panorama Jazz Band has been bringing all kinds of music into all kinds of situations since the mid-90s, always with a strong New Orleans party vibe cultivated over years of entertaining locals and visitors alike in their native Crescent City.

With performances at regional, national and international music festivals, as well as their long-standing Saturday night gig at the Spotted Cat on world famous Frenchmen Street, Panorama's seven players make a party that ranges from the Caribbean to Eastern Europe, Latin America and New Orleans all with a Big Easy feel. Their instrumentation (clarinet, alto saxophone, trombone, accordion, banjo, tuba and drums) lends itself to music from a wide range of international cultures as well that of Jelly Roll Morton, Louis Armstrong, Sidney Bechet, Fats Domino and Professor Longhair.

Beginning in 2003, Panorama began producing and releasing CDs to sell from the bandstand. Their discography now includes eight albums plus dozens of digital-only singles released online monthly through their BandCamp subscription club, "Good Music For You." Their entire catalogue can also be found on Spotify, YouTube, iTunes and other digital outlets.
